

Qualleta, Inc. | Children's Dungeon Master Addendum

Last Updated: July 20, 2026

This Children's Game Master Addendum ("Child GM Addendum") is part of StartPlaying's [Terms of Service](#) and StartPlaying's children platform [Terms of Service](#) (collectively, "Terms of Service") and applies to individuals applying or operating as a Game Master running tabletop roleplaying games for individuals under the age of 18 ("GM"). By applying or continuing to operate as a GM, you agree to this Child GM Addendum, the Terms of Service, and any other supplemental terms or agreements related to our Services. Any capitalized terms not defined in this Child GM Addendum, will have the meaning as defined in the Terms of Service.

1. CHILDREN GAME MASTER OBLIGATIONS AND TERMS

OBLIGATIONS

You agree to develop a tabletop roleplaying campaign(s) and host a virtual session ("Adventure(s)") where you guide, teach, or instruct players under the age of 18 ("Youth Player(s)") through the campaign. You shall organize and schedule the Adventures with the parents or legal guardians of the Youth Players ("Parent(s)") through the children version of our platform and Services ("Child Services").

PLATFORM BASICS

As a GM, you must provide StartPlaying with any information requested in order for StartPlaying to list your Adventures through its Child Services, including but not limited to a description of the Adventure and the price for the Adventure. Each Adventure listed by a GM should follow the [Young Heroes Content Policy](#). StartPlaying reserves the right to reject any potential GM and remove or suspend any GM that violate StartPlaying policies, including, but not limited to the [Code of Conduct](#). StartPlaying will conduct background checks on all potential GMs and you agree to provide written and/or electronic consent to such background checks and to provide accurate and truthful information during such process. StartPlaying may make changes to onboarding or authentication processes for GMs and completion of these processes may be required for GM account activation or continued access and usage of the Services or Child Services.

STANDARDS

To utilize our Child Services, you agree to follow our policies, including the [Code of Conduct](#) and the Children Content Policy. Those expectations include thoughtful and professional communications with the StartPlaying community (e.g. other GMs, Parents, Youth Players), modeling appropriate behavior for Youth Players, and displaying professionalism. In addition, you agree to use social media, blogs, and other online forums, in an appropriate manner and not engage in inappropriate behavior, including, but not limited to:

- Inappropriate behavior in any our Services, including but not limited to our Child Services, such as behavior intended to provoke, bully, demean, or cause harm to others, or to create conflict; or any other posts or content that StartPlaying believes to be uncondusive to a respectful and welcoming community for all.
- Inappropriate behavior in any online forum includes, but is not limited to: posting online or speaking to the media as an agent of StartPlaying without prior written authorization from StartPlaying; posts that StartPlaying finds to be offensive or inappropriate based on race, sex, age, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, national origin, disability or medical condition, veteran status, or any other legally protected characteristic; derogatory, disparaging, or disrespectful comments about any users, Youth Players, other GMs, Parents, or StartPlaying staff, even if the target is not identified by name; sharing any private material, communication, or information regarding any users', other GMs', Youth Players', Parents', or StartPlaying Staff's names, photos, conversations, emails, screenshots of the Adventures, or any other personal identifying

information; posts that may be harmful to StartPlaying's ongoing business operations; sharing content that contains or promotes hate speech, threats of violence, or the endangerment of children; and any other violation of StartPlaying's policies and/or [Code of Conduct](#).

YOUTH PLAYER SAFETY

In accordance with mandated reporting laws, you, as a GM, shall immediately report to StartPlaying any suspected case of child abuse or neglect they become aware of during the Adventures. Consistent with the Federal Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) (42 U.S.C.A. § 5106g), StartPlaying defines "abuse or neglect" as: "any recent act or failure to act on the part of a parent or caretaker, which results in death, serious physical or emotional harm, sexual abuse or exploitation"; or "an act or failure to act which presents an imminent risk of serious harm." GMs who are mandatory reporters under applicable state or local law are required to report suspected abuse or neglect to the appropriate authorities in addition to reporting to StartPlaying. GMs are responsible for understanding and complying with the mandatory reporting laws applicable to them in their jurisdiction. StartPlaying may provide resources to assist GMs in identifying their obligations, but GMs remain solely responsible for compliance with all applicable reporting requirements. StartPlaying itself may report instances of suspected abuse or neglect as it deems appropriate.

GAME MASTER RESPONSIBILITIES

Each GM is solely responsible and liable for obtaining all licenses and other permissions required to offer or provide any Adventures, including, but not limited to, complying with any applicable laws, rules or regulations. StartPlaying assumes no responsibility for a GM's failure to obtain such licenses or permissions or otherwise comply with any applicable laws, rules or regulations.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR RELATIONSHIP

You understand and agree that StartPlaying is not an insurer, agent or employer for you as a GM, and you offer your Adventures on StartPlaying solely as an independent contractor. If a Parent enrolls in any of your Adventures, any agreement you enter into with such Parent is between you and the Parent, and StartPlaying is not a party to that agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, you appoint and authorize StartPlaying to serve as your limited agent purely for the purpose of accepting payments from Parents on your behalf and transmitting such payments to you (minus any StartPlaying fees), such as if payment is made directly to you by the Parent. StartPlaying, as limited payment collection agent for you, agrees to facilitate the payment of any Adventures pursuant to this Child GM Addendum, the Terms of Service, and any other policy, otherwise agreed between StartPlaying and you. In addition, you acknowledge and agree that, as a GM, you are responsible for your own acts and omissions while using our Child Services.

ADVENTURES RECORDINGS

You shall not record, videotape, stream, transmit, broadcast to third parties, or otherwise create a copy of any Adventure in any medium either known or developed in the future without the express written consent of StartPlaying, and the Parents or legal guardian(s) of the Youth Player, acting on behalf of the Youth Player. Violating this section is considered a material breach and StartPlaying reserves the right to seek any available legal remedy, including but not limited to, injunctive relief.

COMMUNICATIONS TO PARENTS AND YOUTH PLAYERS

Each GM is solely responsible to comply with applicable laws, regulations and rules, including, but not limited to, marketing laws and consumer protection laws, when communicating with Parents or Youth Players on our Child Services, such as through messages. For clarity, in-Adventure communication between GMs and Youth Players via the Child Services platform is expected and permitted in the ordinary course of conducting Adventures. You shall not communicate directly with any Youth Player without the express written consent of the Parents and StartPlaying. Communications on our Services may not be used for the following activities:

- Sending unsolicited communications, advertising or promotions, requests for donations, or spam in violation of applicable law;
- Harassing or abusing another member or violating our [Code of Conduct](#); or
- Exchanging personal contact, financial or other information for the purposes of making an off-platform communications, including phone number, address, email, social media handles, external URLs, instructions for money transfer, QR codes, etc.

GAME MASTER CONTENT

You acknowledge and agree StartPlaying may use your UGC, including, but not limited to images of you and/or your Adventure listing information for promotional services to help grow our Child Services. You also agree and acknowledge that StartPlaying may record or create a record of any Adventure you host for quality control purposes and enforcement of any rules or code of conduct. Furthermore, you agree and acknowledge that you shall not have access to said recordings nor will StartPlaying provide you a copy of said recording. Any recordings made by StartPlaying pursuant to this section will be used solely for quality control and policy enforcement purposes, will be accessible only to authorized StartPlaying personnel, and will be retained only for so long as necessary for those purposes or as required by applicable law.

DATA PRIVACY

In connection with your use of the Child Services, you may have incidental access to personal information of Youth Players. You agree not to collect, store, use, or disclose any personal information of Youth Players except as necessary to conduct Adventures, and to handle any such information in accordance with StartPlaying's [Privacy Policy](#) and applicable law, including the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).

2. ADVENTURE PRICES AND PAYMENT

ADVENTURE PRICES

Each GM sets their own Adventure Price, however, no GM shall price an Adventure under \$25 USD.

GAME MASTER PAYMENT

Except as otherwise stated in any other agreement, StartPlaying will transfer the "Payment" (Total Price minus the GM Fee (as defined below) and any other Fees) to GM's Account for each sale of an Adventure to a Parent within a reasonable period of time according to this Child GM Addendum, the Terms of Service, and any other StartPlaying policy. In order to transfer funds to GM's account, GM shall have a registered and active Stripe account.

GM FEE

"GM Fee" shall mean Adventure Price minus StartPlaying's take rate, platform fee, and other fees.

TAXES

You shall be solely responsible for all taxes associated with your Adventures.

TAX INFORMATION

In certain jurisdictions, Tax regulations may require that StartPlaying collect and/or report Tax information about you. If you fail to provide us with documentation that we determine to be sufficient to support any such obligation, we may withhold payouts, until sufficient documentation is provided. You agree that StartPlaying may issue on your behalf invoices or similar documentation for Taxes for your Adventure offerings to facilitate accurate tax reporting.

RECONCILIATION

If you believe your GM Payment was processed incorrectly, please contact StartPlaying support within thirty (30) days of the date you received payment to help reconcile any differences. Thereafter, any issues regarding GM Payments will be considered on a case-by-case basis by StartPlaying support.

3. FURTHER DOCUMENTATION AND COOPERATION

You agree to execute any additional documentation and take any other further action that is or may become necessary to comply with applicable laws. You further agree to reasonably cooperate with StartPlaying in this regard if StartPlaying seeks your assistance.
